





Materials needed:  
Paper, glue, scissors, string and tape.

Step 1: Print out the design.



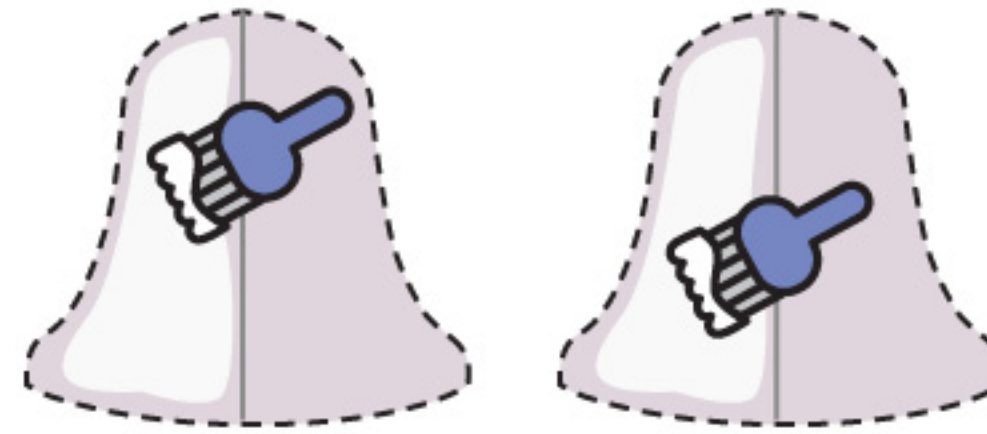
Step 2: Fold the bells along the broken lines



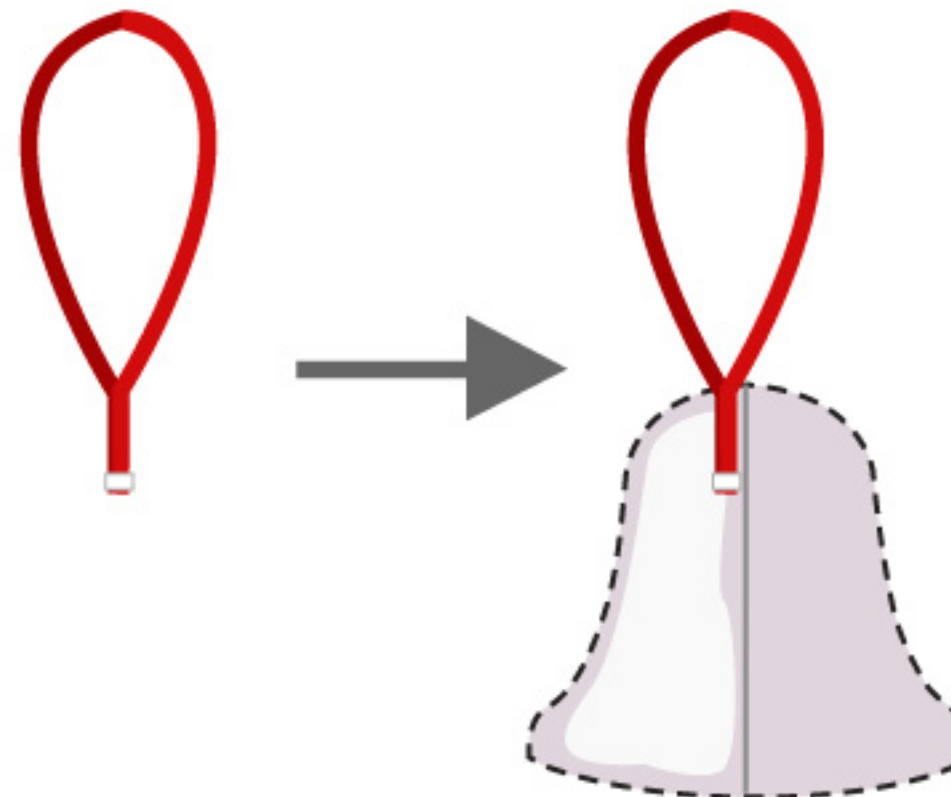
Step 3: Unfold the sheets and cut the bells along the broken lines using the scissors. Make sure you get an adult to help you out with this!



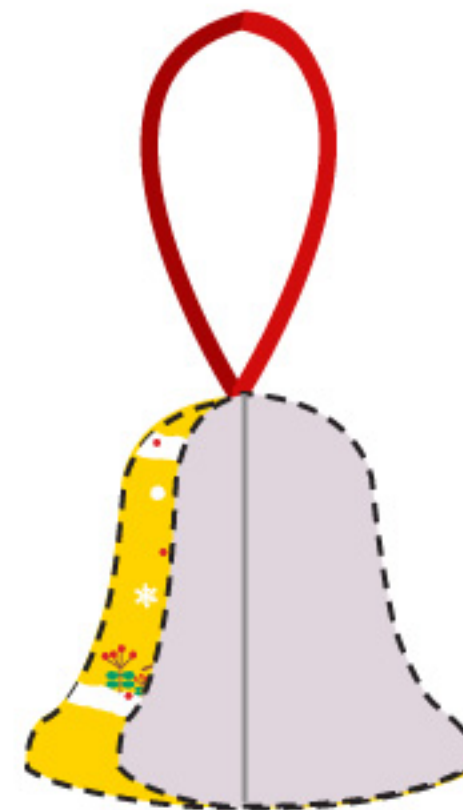
Step 4: Unfold one of the bells and place it on a flat surface, with the printed side down. Use glue on its left folded side.



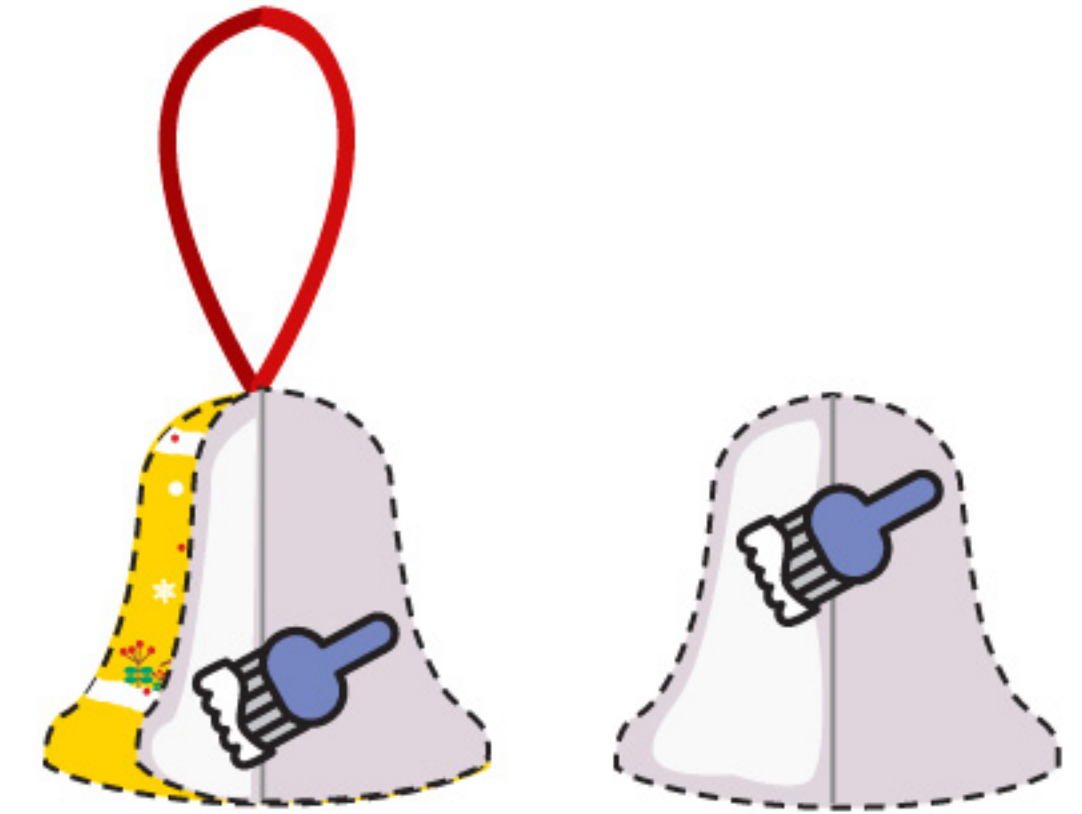
Step 5: Get a length of string (10 inches will do nicely). Fold it in half and tape the two ends together. Stick it on to the first bell, setting it up as close to the middle as possible. Press down firmly to make sure it sticks.



Step 6: Get another one of the bells and stick it on to the one that you have, printed side up. Make sure the edges are aligned! Fold back the sides of the bells that are not glued together.



Step 7: Spread some glue on the remaining areas of the bell and carefully place the last one on it, making sure that it is aligned with the other two. Press them firmly so that the ornament stays together.



Congratulations! You now have a Christmas bell!
